

NORMATIVE INSTRUCTION CPPGBIOEN – 004/2014

Concerning the obligations of CAPES scholarship holders of the Integrated Postgraduate Program in Bioenergy

Considering the need for a formal description of the procedures referring to the obligations of CAPES scholarship holders of the Doctorate in Bioenergy and **CAPES n° 76/2010 Ministerial Order**, which deals with the regulation of the Social Demand Program, the Postgraduate Commission of the Food Engineering Faculty, using its legal attributions, established:

Article 1 – A CAPES scholarship holder of the Program should carry out Teacher Training as specified below:

I: a student who receives twelve (12) uninterrupted months of scholarship should carry out one (1) semester of Teacher Training during the Program.

II: a student who receives more than twenty-four (24) months of scholarship should carry out a minimum of two (2) and maximum of three (3) semesters of Teacher Training during the Program, as stipulated in current CAPES legislation.

Single paragraph – A higher education professor, with proof of such activities during the period of the scholarship, will be exempted from teacher training.

Article 2 – Students with scholarships should show adequate development in their research project and obtain approval of their annual activity reports.

Single paragraph – The scholarships can be interrupted at any moment in time, at the discretion of CPPGBIOEN due to failing courses or low yields as communicated by the advisor.

Article 3 - Special and missing cases will be analyzed by the Postgraduate Program in Bioenergy Commission.
