Course goals

By the end of the course, the learner will be able to: understand the academic writing process; prepare appropriate and accurate scientific papers in English; become more independent in academic writing.

Content

- The writing process: genre analysis; finding suitable sources; developing critical approaches; structuring an academic paper; paraphrasing; references and quotation; plagiarism.
- Elements of writing: cohesion/coherence; cause and effect; style; visual information.
- Accuracy in writing: articles; prepositions; punctuation; conjunctions; passive/active voices; verb tenses; caution.
- The publication process: selecting journals, interacting with reviewers and editors
