### OBJETIVOS:

Improve academic writing skills for students enrolled in graduate programmes on Food Engineering, leading to consistent academic writing of essays and scientific papers.

### PROGRAMA:

The course aims to thoroughly explain the writing process and covers all the key writing skills, providing some proficiency in a few key areas of 'academic' grammar, learn about the stages in essay writing, how to organise an essay, use academic writing style and cover key areas of grammar. It aims to explain the writing process, from understanding the literature review to data discussion and final manuscript with all the related sections. Each part is split into short sections containing explanations, diagrams and exercises, so that by the end of the course students will be able to write a good, basic academic essay. Teaching will be carried out by guiding and instructing the writer in the areas of content, organisation, language and the process of planning and drafting an essay.

1. Choosing an appropriate journal
2. Features of academic writing
3. Essay organization and structure: Results; Material and methods, Discussion; Conclusion; Introduction; Title; Abstract and keywords. Cover letter; response to reviewers
4. Focus on the writing stages
5. Your first essay: feedback and redrafting

### AVALIAÇÃO:

The student must submit a draft for an academic essay (scientific paper, conference paper, or other essay).
